Vacancy – Position of Fitter

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to fill a temporary position of Gas Fitter at the National Petroleum Corporation (NPC). The successful candidate will be required to commence working with two weeks' notice. ***Would this be you?***

What is involved in this job?

Primary Objective

To install natural gas pipeline mains, internal (i.e. within customer's property from ball valve to appliance) and external (i.e. from pipeline main to ball valve) gas services according to the efficiency, safety and work standards of the NPC.

Required Qualifications, Skills

1. Part I City and Guilds in Plumbing/Pipefitting and experience in pipe fitting, preferably in an oil and gas environment or at least eight (8) years' experience in a gas operation.
2. Specialised Training - Certificate or Diploma in Gas Fitting from an accredited institution of technology
3. Must possess good interpersonal skills and good professional ethics.
4. A valid **heavy-duty vehicle driver's license**. Evidence of such must be provided.
5. Ability to work unsupervised and be self-motivating

Duties Include but are not limited to

1. Installing external and internal natural gas pipeline services, and executing stove/oven or appliance adjustments to burners, etc.
2. Repairing and maintaining distribution mains, pipelines and any other fittings and fixtures which make up the NPC's natural gas transmission and distribution network.
3. Carrying out pressure tests as necessary on transmission and distribution pipelines and natural gas services, interpreting and analysing results as shown to determine integrity.
4. Checking and ensuring that trenches have been excavated to NPC's specification before commencement of on-site activities.
5. Giving instructions to and directing the activities of general workers/labourers while on work sites and reporting accordingly.
6. Writing daily activity reports in workbooks, filling in job cards and using the computer for word processing.
7. Evaluating the site and NPC's accompanying workers to ensure appropriate health and safety measures are in place before, during and after the conclusion of work activities.
8. Any other duties compatible with the post that may be assigned by the Superintendent/Foreman, Engineer or Manager of Technical Operations.

Working Conditions

Outdoor, exposure to sun, rain, dust and noise; carries and operates heavy tools in awkward positions and works in trenches from time to time, depending on the demands of the job.
